



HEATHFIELD PRIMARY SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY

- All students are expected to wear the school uniform. This includes wearing uniforms at public events such as excursions, performances, sporting events and any functions where the students participate in a representative capacity.
- Parents/caregivers are responsible for the purchase and wearing of the school uniform.
- Parents/caregivers wishing to gain student exemption from the wearing of school uniform may do so in writing to the Principal.

Exemption can be granted on the following grounds:

1. Religious/cultural
2. New students (after one month, HPS uniform required)
3. Itinerant students
4. Financial hardship
5. Medical or family sickness reasons.

In the event of no communication in relation to the above, an unfair responsibility may be placed on the student and we try to avoid that. In such cases the Principal will communicate directly with the parents/caregivers.

- In keeping with “Sunsmart” guidelines, legionnaire, broadrim or bucket style hats must be worn for all outdoor activities during Terms 1 and 4. (*Caps do not provide adequate protection.*)
- A selection of new and second-hand uniforms is available at the school.
- Order forms are available from the front office.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

Our school uniform colours are red and bottle (dark) green.
The following items are available from the Front Office.

Short sleeve polo shirt with logo
Long sleeved polo shirt with logo
Hoodie windcheater with logo
Summer dress
Bucket hat with logo

Grey tights (winter)
Jersey Pinafore dress (sizes 11 -14)
Pleated grey skirt
Pinafore Dress (sizes 5-6 and 7-10)

Appropriate footwear must be worn at all time (no thongs).
Year 7 students can purchase tops with special design (available early Term 1).
